





Benefits Basics #8:Is the Emergency Room Your Best Bet?

If you needed medical care in a hurry, where would you go? Think you'd head for the emergency room? This issue of Benefits Basics explains why you might want to think twice about that, and where you can go instead.

What You Need to Know about ER Costs and Alternatives

If you have a true life-threatening emergency, it makes sense to call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room. But, know that you'll pay a lot if your emergency turns out to be *non-life-threatening*. In that case, the PPO Plan pays only \$75 of emergency room charges and you pay the balance, which could be as much as \$3,000 per visit. And the HMO Plan pays nothing if your emergency isn't life threatening. It's important to understand that this applies to all types of emergency room visits, including community hospitals with free-standing ERs, such as Dignity Health.

CONVENIENCE CARE/RETAIL HEALTH CLINICS

- When to Use: In many cases, convenience care and retail health clinics will meet your non-urgent, non-emergency medical needs, such as:
 - Diagnostic lab tests
 - General health screenings
 - Minor wound treatment and repairs
 - Minor illnesses
 - Preventive care and some immunizations
 - Blood pressure checks
 - Treatment of minor burns and sprains
 - Routine physicals and sports physicals

> What You'll Pay: →

- PPO Plan in-network copay: \$10
- HMO Plan in-network copay: \$25

Where to Go:

- PPO Plan: CVS MinuteClinicTM or Walgreen's Take Care Clinic.
- HMO Plan: Southwest Medical Associates (SMA) Convenient Care Clinic listed at www.smalv.com/en/OurCenters/ConvenientCares.

URGENT CARE CENTERS

- When to Use: These centers are often open for extended hours, including nights and weekends, so visit one for an illness or injury that needs immediate attention, but doesn't require a trip to the emergency room, such as:
 - Most fractures
 - Ear infections
 - Colds and other respiratory problems
 - Sprains and strains
 - Abdominal pain
 - Vomiting and diarrhea
 - Most cuts
 - Most burns
 - Back pain

What You'll Pay:

- **PPO Plan in-network copay:** \$15 after deductible
- HMO Plan in-network copay: \$40

Understanding Your Employee Assistance Program

We frequently get questions from members about the Teamsters Local 14 Employee Assistance Program (EAP), offered through Harmony Healthcare for all members and their immediate families. You may not know that the EAP provides two services, described below.

MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT AUTHORIZATION

If you or a covered family member needs treatment for mental health issues or substance abuse, you must contact Harmony Healthcare for authorization and use a Harmony Healthcare network provider. If you use a non-network provider, you will pay a much larger share of the cost. The Harmony Healthcare network includes two main clinics, plus over 220 individual providers throughout the Las Vegas area.

FREE, CONFIDENTIAL COUNSELING FOR PERSONAL AND FAMILY CONCERNS


The Employee Assistance Program (EAP) provides up to four free visits for professional, confidential counseling for you and your immediate family members.
