Visits to Teamsters Family Wellness Centers Continue to Grow!

On May 8, Teamsters Security Fund for Southern Nevada—Local 14 held a grand opening celebration in Northwest Las Vegas for its second Wellness Center. Leaders from the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Joint Council 42 President Randy Cammack and Las Vegas mayor Carolyn Goodman joined clinic staff for a well-attended ribbon cutting ceremony.

The first Wellness Center opened in Henderson this past February. Since then, both locations have accommodated nearly 1,000 appointments—all at no out-of-pocket cost.

Wellness Centers offer affordable, confidential, convenient health care to all Teamsters Security Fund for Southern Nevada—Local 14 members and their families.

This month, the Henderson Wellness Center will begin dispensing free prescription medication, and the Northwest Las Vegas location will soon follow. To see a list of available medications, visit wp.activatehealthcare.com/teamsters14/drugs.

No Flu for You!

Flu season starts in September, and Teamsters Local 14's Wellness Centers are already preparing. Children, adults 65 and older and pregnant women are among the groups at highest risk for complications from the flu, but **everyone** should get vaccinated. Love Your Skin!

Protect yourself from the sun this summer. Skin cancer is highly treatable if you catch it early, so see a dermatologist once a year to make sure your skin is healthy. PPO participants only have to pay a \$15 copay for an in-network dermatologist, and HMO participants only pay a \$70 copay.

Open Enrollment for 2020 health coverage will run from October 15 - November 15, 2019. This is your annual opportunity to enroll in or change your medical and/or dental plan, add or drop eligible dependents, and update your beneficiary information. Any changes will take effect on January 1, 2020.

Reminder: If your spouse has the option to enroll in another group medical plan, but instead chooses the Fund's medical plan as primary coverage, you will be required to complete an online Spousal Affidavit during Open Enrollment. Keep an eye out for more information in the next few months.
